We have arranged a fantastic opportunity and experience for our children in Willow Class. On **Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> February** we are planning to take Willow Class on a trip to London to visit the Houses of Parliament. This trip is to support Year 6's work on understanding British Values and give them a greater understanding of how democracy works.

We will be catching the 9.24am train from Pulborough train station and we would appreciate if you could arrange for your child to be at the train station for 9am. We hope to return to Pulborough at 8.20pm where we would be grateful for you to collect your child. However, obviously this may change due to unforeseen circumstances. We will keep you informed of any changes.

While in London, we are also hoping to show the children some of the sights, such as Downing Street, St James Park, Horse Guards, National Gallery and Buckingham Palace.
