Littlehampton Beach Trip

During the first half of the summer term Oak Class will be learning about animals and their habitat, linked to our topic of interest. In light of this, I have arranged for the children to spend the day at Littlehampton Beach!

This trip will take place on **Monday 18th May**. We will be leaving school at 9am so children should arrive at school at normal time. We will be returning to school in time for school pickup at 3.15pm.

Please could the children bring a packed lunch and plenty to drink. Since we will be at the beach and outside for the majority of the day, the children can wear non-school uniform. Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather.

For this trip, children will need the following:

- **Suitable footwear**
- **A waterproof jacket**
- **A named small rucksack**
- **An extra carton or bottle of drink**
- **A small hand towel**
- **Sun cream (weather dependent)**
- **A sun hat (weather dependent)**

Whilst at the beach, the children will be participating in educational activities relating to our topic and other areas of learning that benefit from the beach trip. The children will also be offered some free time to play in the sand and paddle in the water. We will check with the Coast Guard on the day whether it is safe to go in the water. We will end our day with an ice-cream, if there are any allergies please let us know.

To cover the costs of this trip we are asking for a donation of £5 payable on the MCAS system. By paying the contribution via MCAS, this is accepted as consent for your child to attend this trip.
