**Year 6 Trip to Paulton's Park on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2025**

This term, Willow class will begin a D+T and science project exploring the engineering, forces and electronics associated with amusement parks.

As part of the design and research process (and as a thank you for all of their hard work in the build-up to SATs), we are excited to invite your children on a trip to **Paulton's Park on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2025**. The children will have time to explore the park and go on the rides, if they wish.

To enable this trip to go ahead, we will be asking for a voluntary contribution of £15 to cover the cost of entrance, transport to and from Paulton's Park. By paying the contribution via the MCAS system, this is accepted as consent for your child to attend this trip and to travel on the school minibus.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch, water bottle and a couple of snacks as it will be a long day. Your children may wear comfortable clothing and suitable footwear, but must wear either their school jumper or P.E. hoodie.
