Dear Parents/Carers,

Following the success of our 2023 event, we are delighted to announce that once again we will be holding a Colour Run as our main event - alongside the usual raffle, tombola and other stalls.

The children will be running a course with some small obstacles set around the grounds of the school approximately 500min length (which can be run multiple times by older children) whilst coloured powder is thrown at them by enthusiastic volunteers.

The children will go in waves by age - parents, carers and other family members are welcome to join them (please ensure you include all individuals planning to run in the

sponsorship form details to ensure we have enough coloured powder to run the event).

We will be providing a white t-shirt and sunglasses for all those children taking part from the school (as well as a medal once completed). Any parents, carers or family members taking part will need to bring their own T-shirts and sunglasses.

If any child still has sunglasses and T-shirt from the 2023 colour run, if they could be recycled and re-used this year that would be amazing.

We ask that each child wanting to take part obtains sponsorship using the sponsorship form attached in order to help fund the cost of the event.



PLEASE ENSURE ALL FORMS ARE RETURNED BY FRIDAY 21ST JUNE OR YOUR CHILD MAY NOT BE ABLE TO TAKE PART IN THE RUN.

We will need volunteers to help run the stalls for the event - any parents, carers or family members who volunteer will also be included in the team throwing the coloured powders over the runners.

The Summer Colour Run Fair is one of the main fund-raising activities for the year run by the PPSA, where all profits go towards helping the school to run various events or activities for the children, which they might not have the budget for otherwise and we look forward to your support for the event.

As mentioned, there are a number of elements to the fair, and if you are able to support us in the run up to the fair by getting involved in any of the activities below, we really appreciate it.

Friday 14th June is **"Bring a Bottle" day** in exchange for your child coming to school in **dress down**. The bottles can be anything from tomato ketchup to shampoo and wine to bubble bath! Everything is gratefully accepted.

We will be holding a <u>RAFFLE</u>. There are going to be some great prizes, from local businesses and charities so please sell or buy as many tickets as you can!

You've got to be in it to win it!

We are sending two raffle books home with each child, which we would be grateful if you could try to sell. If you need extra, these will be available at the office. If you know of anyone who might be willing to donate a prize please do let the school office know by giving their details and a member of the PPSA can get in touch with them.



We are also planning to hold a <u>TOMBOLA</u> - similar to previous years, different coloured boxes will be put in each classroom year and any items you can donate of that colour would be greatly appreciated and will form part of the tombola. The items can be anything - tea bags, chocolate, soap, stationary - whatever you can think of that fits the colour! The class with the most items will win a small prize for the children.

Each class will have a colour to follow:

Oak - Rainbow Ash - Blue Rowan - Green Beech - Red Maple - Orange Elm - Yellow Willow - Purple

As of **Tuesday 4th June**, we would be grateful to receive items for the boxes - they will be in the classroom for 2 weeks (the last date for donations will be Tuesday 17th June)

TEDDY TOMBOLA - We would really appreciate if you have any clean, good as new teddies, looking for new owners that you would donate them to our Teddy Tombola. Please hand any donations in to the office. Please could all teddies (or other stuffed items) be donated by **Friday 18**th **June**.

<u>CAKES</u> - We enclose a paper plate with this letter and the raffle tickets - please send in cakes on this plate on Friday 21st June to be sold at the fair. These can be home-baked or shop bought!

There will be other stalls on the day, including refreshments and lots more.
