Dear Parents/Carers,

Elm Class trip to Legoland on Friday 20th March 2026

This term, Elm Class are learning about the Ancient Greek civilisation. Our learning will be guided by the question: How did Ancient Greece sustain a successful civilisation? As part of this, the children will learn about the military success of the Greeks, how different city states organised their government and the importance of cultural and philosophical ideas during this era.

As part of this leaning, I am pleased to inform you about an exciting educational trip planned for Elm Class pupils to LEGOLAND on Friday 20th March 2026. The children will have time to explore the park, and, of course, go on the rides, if they wish. Not only will they have the opportunity to explore the park, but also have the unique opportunity to participate in an Ancient Greek workshop offered by LEGOLAND. This will consolidate their knowledge on the significant aspects of the Ancient Greek civilisation and gain historical perspective through LEGO.

To enable this trip to go ahead, we will be asking for a voluntary contribution of £18 to cover the cost of entrance and transport to and from Legoland. By paying the contribution via the MCAS system, this is accepted as consent for your child to attend this trip and to travel on the school minibus or by a member of staff's car.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch, water bottle and a couple of snacks as it will be a long day. Your children may wear comfortable clothing and suitable footwear, but please can they wear their school jumper or PE hoodie.

On the day of the trip, children will need to be at school by 7:50am as we will be leaving promptly at 8am to ensure we arrive at the park by 10am when we can go in. The children will travel either in a school mini-bus or in a member of staff's car. We will aim to leave the park at around 4pm and expect to return to school by 6pm, so children will need to be picked up from school at this time.
